

Visiting Pet Policy

It is the goal of Whitetail Resort and the Great Outdoors Festival Committee to maintain a family atmosphere at our Festival. In saying this, we understand that pets are an integral part of many families. While we do not prohibit our guests from bringing their pets to the Festival we do have some guidelines that have been developed for the safety and enjoyment of all of our guests including our four legged ones. Please be aware that the Festival will have many people – adults and children. Please know that there will be many activities, sounds, smells and distractions that may affect our pets in different ways.

Please follow the below guidelines so that every Pet, Pet Owner and Non-Pet owner has a wonderful experience at the festival.

- All visiting pets, must be on a leash and controlled by a responsible adult at all times
- Leashes may be no longer than 4 feet.
- All pets must be healthy and currently vaccinated.
- Owners are responsible for the immediate clean up and proper disposal of any and all animal waste produced by their visiting pet.
- Visiting Dogs are prohibited from the following areas;
 - Dock Dog Staging Area
 - Barnyard Buddies -Petting Zoo Area
 - Wild birds of Prey Area
 - Keystone Reptile Area
 - Pony/Horse Riding Area

NOTE: Well behaved, dogs may be allowed in the stands for those Dock Dog events. However

Pet owners are required to keep control of their pet(s) at all times. The resort reserves the right to have any pet removed from the grounds for any reason that our Festival staff may deem a danger, hazard, or a nuisance. In the event an unruly or nuisance pet and/or their owners need to be evicted from the festival grounds no refunds or any fees will be granted.

Absolutely, no pets will be left in unattended vehicles or left unattended on the grounds by their owner or agent.
